



AIM OF THE GAME

Can you roll it?

You roll the two dice and the numbers shown on the dice will determine your luck. On some bets you win with 7, on some you lose. When do you win or lose? Read on to find out more.

In this booklet only the simple rules and bets are explained. Ask the croupier for more explanation.



CASINO CHIPS

To play you need casino chips. You can get them at the cashier or from the croupier at the table.

Simply put your money on the table and the croupier will exchange it for casino chips.

TIP Start with a small bet to learn.



PLAY THE PASS LINE

Start a simple bet by placing a chip on the Pass line. Players take turn in throwing (shooting) the dice.

When it is your turn the croupier will place five dice in front of you. Pick any two, which will be your Lucky Dice.



SHOOT!

Take the two dice in your hand and throw them to the other side of the table, not too soft, not too hard!

The croupier calls out the total points and will move the dice towards the centre of the table.



COME OUT

The first roll is called "Come Out Roll". You have played the Pass Line bet, so three things can happen:

7 or 11: You win on your first roll, even money on your bet and you can shoot again.

2, 3 or 12: you lose, Craps!

Any other number: the game continues.



POINT ESTABLISHED

Is your first roll 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10? Then you have established a Point. The croupier will place the puck "ON" on the number you threw. Then you shoot again.

When you shoot your Point on your second roll: the Pass Line bet gets paid even money. The puck goes OFF again and you start a new Come Out roll.

When you shoot a 7: you lose, new shooter.

Any other number: you continue shooting until you roll a 7 or your Point.



ODDS BET

When a Point has been established you can increase your bet behind the Pass Line.

Then, when you shoot your Point, the extra bet will also be paid.

Your point is:
4 & 10: you win 2 to 1
5 & 9: you win 3 to 2
6 & 8: you win 6 to 5

TIP This is the best bet in Craps!



COME BET

When a Point has been established you can make the COME bet.

7 or 11: you win even money

2, 3 or 12: you lose

Any other number: that number becomes your Come Point.

The same rules apply now as an established Point.



PLACE BETS

When a Point has been established you can make a Place Bet.

Ask the croupier to place your chips on the boxes 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10

If your number comes, you win:
4 & 10: 9 to 5
5 & 9: 7 to 5
6 & 8: 7 to 6

When 7 comes, you lose.



OTHER BETS

Craps have many more types of bets:

Don't Pass Line

- Works the same as the Pass Line bet, however now the opposite numbers win

Big 6 & 8

- Wins with 6 or 8, loses with 7

Hardways

- Roll doubles: 6 + 6, 5 + 5

The croupier will be able to explain these in further detail for you.

QUICK START

Start with a Pass Line bet



Shoot!
7 or 11: you win
2, 3 or 12: Craps, you lose
Other number: Puck goes "ON" on number

Shoot again!
Your number: you win
7: you lose
